Our district is in the midst of an exciting transformation ensuring that all of our students are performing at high levels and are prepared to succeed in higher education. Based on the significant improvements we are making, SAISD has been named "one of the fastest improving districts in the state" by TEA Commissioner Mike Morath. This success is due in part to the purposeful, targeted work of our dedicated Master Teachers.

In SAISD, we believe that the teacher, more than any other factor, has the ability to affect student outcomes. We believe that all students are capable of greatness, and deserve a champion who will help them succeed.

The Master Teacher Initiative partners experienced teachers who have a proven track record of success with vulnerable students, moving them from "at risk" to "at promise." The goal of the Master Teacher is to accelerate a student's learning ensuring that each child reaches his or her maximum potential.

We are currently recruiting teachers PreK-12 in all content areas who meet the Master Teacher eligibility criteria to join our team for the 2019-2020 school year.



Master Teachers work closely with our most at risk students in an Extended Day schedule, usually 5 additional hours a week.



Master Teachers work 20 additional days during the school year and summer, 10 with children and 10 in professional learning.

Do you have what it takes to join this elite group of professional educators?

Eligible teachers include those who have:

- At least two years of successful teaching as measured by performance evaluations and student data.
- Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university.
- Valid Texas Teaching Certificate with required endorsements for subject and level assigned.



Master Teachers are compensated up to **\$15,000** above their regular salary for the additional days and extended time worked.

Secondary Math or Science teachers, bilingual teachers, and special education teachers may be eligible for additional stipends based on their teaching assignment.



Master Teachers at some campuses are eligible to pursue tuition free advanced degrees at one of our four higher education partners: Relay Graduate School, UTSA, OLLU, and Texas A&M San Antonio.

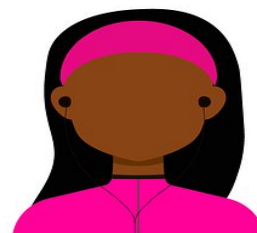
