



District's 2016–19 Strategic Plan will enable us to fulfill mission with maximum efficiency and impact. It focuses expression of the instructional core while leveraging the ut of collaborative teams that include our administrators, shers, students and stakeholders. This plan articulates seific goals and describes the action steps and resources eded to accomplish them. It reflects a proactive approach to anaging current performance while maintaining the ability respond to internal and external changes.

During BCPS review of internal and external factors, which neluded the implementation of new Florida Standards, students' literacy skills in the early years, current instruction practices, professional development models, existing internal management practices and stakeholder feedback, it was determined that for 2016–19 we would recalibrate our existing Strategic Plan. Recalibration involves establishing new baselines and a new path forward incorporating elements of our 2012–15 Strategic Plan.

The 2016–19 Strategic Plan utilizes a shorter planning horizon with an emphasis on execution, monitoring and reporting, which enables more frequent reviews and course corrections.

Year 1 Deal with areas that provide the greatest performance improvement opportunities using existing resources.



Leverage outcomes and discoveries from previous years while targeting programs in specific challenge areas.




